**Code Reference** FAC: Maintenance & Repair 64E-13.004(3)(b)(c). Buildings shall be kept clean and in good repair, free from hazardous conditions, such as loose or broken floor tiles and boards; loose moldings; loose hanging fixtures, pipes, and electric wires; and broken plaster. Furnishings and equipment shall be kept clean and in good repair, free of missing parts and hazards such as sharp edges, splinters, and protruding or rusty nails.

**Violation #15** Provide paper towels and liquid hand soap in boys restroom 117  
**Code Reference** FAC: Handwash Facilities 64E-13.004(6)(b). Handwashing facilities shall be located within or adjoining each toilet room. Soap dispensers shall be provided at all wash basins and liquid or powdered soap shall be used. Individual towels, preferably paper shall be used. Use of common or public towels is prohibited. Hot-air hand drying devices

**Violation #23** Eliminate roach droppings in classrooms cabinets throughout campus (ex. classrooms 104, 106, and 220). No roach activity was found at time of inspection.  
**Code Reference** FAC: Infestation/Control 64E-13.004(10). Effective measures shall be used to prevent harborage, propagation, or infestations of rodents and all insects.
